

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

9TH DAY OF MARCH, 2016

The Board of Directors of the Mehlville Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, met at the Mehlville Conference Room, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis County, Missouri, on the 9th day of March, 2016.

Present at the meeting were:

Aaron Hilmer, Chairman and Director of the Board.

Bonnie C. Stegman, Treasurer and Director of the Board;

Edmond Ryan, Secretary and Director of the Board; and

Brian Hendricks, Fire Chief of the Mehlville Fire Protection District.

Mr. Hilmer called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and announced the Board to be in session for the transaction of business.

Dr. Stegman made a motion to pay the bills of March 9, 2016. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Hendricks requested permission to issue an RFP for one 75-foot aerial apparatus, in line with the apparatus plan, to be delivered in 2017. Mr. Ryan said he would review the RFP.

Mr. Hilmer then made a motion that a closed meeting be held for the purpose of discussing legal and personnel matters immediately following the adjournment of the regular meeting. Mr. Hilmer, as part of said motion, moved that said closed meeting not be open to members of the general public under the provisions of Chapter 610 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, commonly referred to as the Sunshine Act. The motion was seconded by Dr. Stegman. A roll call vote on said motion was taken.

Director Stegman yea.


Director Ryan yea.




