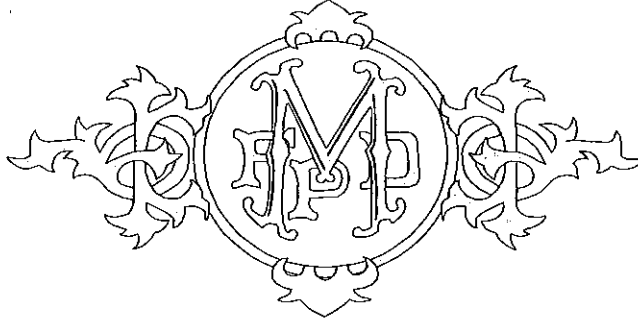

Sealed bids will be received by the Mehlvilleville Fire Protection District at its Administration Office, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis, Missouri 63123, before the closing time and date shown above. **Bids must be returned in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Purchasing Agent, Mehlville Fire Protection District, and have the bid number, and the company clearly marked on the outside envelope. No late bids will be accepted.**

Bids are to be submitted in accordance with the attached Mehlville Fire Protection District specifications attached hereto.

A copy of these specifications must be submitted with each bid, and shall become a part of the final contract. Bid will not be considered if a copy of these specifications is not made a part of the bid proposal. Bidder shall clearly denote any deviation from specifications outlined in the document. Absence of such comment shall imply compliance with specifications. Failure to deliver or provide items listed in these specifications may result in adjusted payment by buyer.

The undersigned agrees, if the bid is accepted, to furnish any and all items upon which prices are offered, at the prices(s) and upon the terms and conditions contained in the specifications. The period for acceptance of this proposal shall be 30 calendar days.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

The Mehlville Fire Protection District is seeking proposals for concrete work in the front of Engine House #5. The qualified vendors must bid the total cost to saw cut, remove and replace an approximate 36' x 72' section of pavement, with 62 linear feet of curb, to the left of the bay doors. In addition, vendor is to remove and replace the 10' x 17' front entry slab.

At the time of submission, each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read the scope and be thoroughly familiar with the project plans and contract documents. The failure or omission of any bidder to examine any form or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation with respect to this bid.

A copy of these specifications must be submitted with each bid, and shall become a part of the final contract. Bid will not be considered if a copy of these specifications is not made a part of the bid proposal. Bidder shall clearly denote any deviation from specifications outlined in the document. Absence of such comment shall imply compliance with specifications. Failure to submit ALL forms and information required in this ITB may be ground for disqualification.

The contractor will furnish a proposal and price for all materials, labor and equipment to complete the job. The successful bidder will be required to work closely with the Mehlville Fire Department on all phases of the project.

Any bids not received prior to the scheduled opening date and time will be rejected.

The contractor must be an on-going entity for at least 5 years.

The contractor is required to produce a valid certificate of liability insurance which must be on hand prior to work beginning.

Only those qualified bidders shall be considered for further evaluation.
