

To Residents of Mehlville Fire Protection District:

The District is following established CDC/St. Louis County Department of Public Health Guidelines when responding to calls that may place emergency responders in contact with a patient exhibiting symptoms of flu-like illness. As a result, Mehlville Firefighters and Paramedics are taking extra precaution to ensure the safety of first responders and the public. In Mehlville Fire Protection District, if you call 911 for a sick case, you will be questioned about whether the patient has a fever or a persistent cough. When MFPD personnel arrive at your location, our crews may fit the patient with a mask and maintain limited exposure with the patient. That Mehlville paramedic will be wearing Personal Protective Equipment that may include a: Barrier gown, Medical exam gloves, Eye protection and Respirator.

At this time, Mehlville Fire Protection District is cancelling all scheduled public relation events including child safety seat installations and smoke detector installations. No new events can be scheduled until further notice.
