MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MEHLVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, ON THE 20TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2021

The Board of Directors of the Mehlville Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, met at the Mehlville Conference Room, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis County, Missouri, on the 20th day of October, 2021.

Present at the meeting were:

Aaron Hilmer, Chairman and Director of the Board;

Bonnie C. Stegman, Treasurer and Director of the Board;

Edmond Ryan, Secretary and Director of the Board; and

Brian Hendricks, Fire Chief of the Mehlville Fire Protection District.

Mr. Hilmer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and announced the Board to be in session for the transaction of business.

Mr. Ryan made a motion to approve the Board meeting minutes of September 8, 22 and 29, 2021. Dr. Stegman seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Dr. Stegman made a motion to pay the bills of October 13 and 20, 2021. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Financial Officer Brian Bond presented the September, 2021 Financial Statements. Due to certain retroactive adjustments, the District did not receive any 2020 tax revenue during September. Cash equivalent resources at September 30 were \$20.958 million, a \$431,000 or 2% decrease from 2020. The District received \$2,500 from the sale of a Crown Vic. The District spent \$57,000 for several items including a new ambulance chassis. The General Fund appears to be slightly ahead of the 2021 budget primarily due to unscheduled overtime. At the end of September, the District had

exceeded the total 2021 budget for unscheduled overtime by \$31,000. If the District remains on pace with 2020, the unscheduled overtime budget will be exceeded by approximately \$300,000. The Pension Fund appears to be on course with the 2021 budget. Dr. Stegman made a motion to approve the September, 2021 Financial Statement and Treasurer's Report as presented. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Hilmer made a motion that a closed meeting be held for the purpose of discussing personnel matters immediately following the adjournment of the regular meeting. Mr. Hilmer, as part of said motion, moved that said closed meeting not be open to members of the general public under the provisions of Chapter 610 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, commonly referred to as the Sunshine Act. The motion was seconded by Dr. Stegman. A roll call vote on said motion was taken.

Director Hilmer yea.

Director Stegman yea.

Director Ryan yea.

There being no further business, Mr. Hilmer adjourned the meeting at 6:05 p.m.
