MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MEHLVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, ON THE 24TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019

The Board of Directors of the Mehlville Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, met at the Mehlville Conference Room, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis County, Missouri, on the 24th day of April, 2019.

Present at the meeting were:

Aaron Hilmer, Chairman and Director of the Board;

Bonnie C. Stegman, Treasurer and Director of the Board;

Edmond Ryan, Secretary and Director of the Board; and

Brian Hendricks, Fire Chief of the Mehlville Fire Protection District.

Mr. Hilmer called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and announced the Board to be in session for the transaction of business.

Mr. Ryan made a motion to approve the Board meeting minutes of March 13 and 27, 2019. Dr. Stegman seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Dr. Stegman made a motion to pay the bills of April 17 and 24, 2019. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Financial Officer Brian Bond presented the March, 2019 Financial Statements. \$204,000 of 2018 tax revenue was received from St. Louis County, bringing the total tax revenues receipts to \$14.555 million, approximately 86.8% of calculated tax revenue. In March, capital expenditures included \$47,000 for a new ambulance chassis. The General Fund is slightly ahead of pace due to the annual workers' compensation premium paid in January, six months of dispatching fees and other prepaid expenses. Otherwise, both the General Fund and the Pension Fund currently appear to be on course

with the 2019 budget. Dr. Stegman made a motion to approve the March 2019 Financial Statement and Treasurer's Report as presented. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Ryan took the oath of office for his new term as Board director.

Mr. Ryan made a motion to approve a fire hydrant resolution cancelling two hydrants in an abandoned street development in the Sunset Drive subdivision. Dr. Stegman seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Hilmer made a motion that a closed meeting be held for the purpose of discussing legal matters immediately following the adjournment of the regular meeting. Mr. Hilmer, as part of said motion, moved that said closed meeting not be open to members of the general public under the provisions of Chapter 610 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, commonly referred to as the Sunshine Act. The motion was seconded by Dr. Stegman. A roll call vote on said motion was taken.

Director Hilmer yea.

Director Stegman yea.

Director Ryan yea.

There being no further business, Mr. Hilmer adjourned the meeting at 5:08 p.m.
