

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE MEHLVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF  
ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, ON THE  
15<sup>th</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2023

The Board of Directors of the Mehlville Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, met at the Mehlville Conference Room, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis County, Missouri, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023.

Present at the meeting were:

Aaron Hilmer, Chairman and Director of the Board,

Bonnie C. Stegman, Treasurer and Director of the Board;

Edmond Ryan, Secretary and Director of the Board; and

Brian Hendricks, Fire Chief of the Mehlville Fire Protection District.

Mr. Hilmer called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and announced the Board to be in session for the transaction of business.

Dr. Stegman made a motion to pay the bills of November 8 and 15, 2023. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A representative from USI discussed renewal of medical, dental, and vision insurance, and long-term disability renewal.

Chief Brian Hendricks discussed approving EMoPP changes regarding assigning seniority to personnel, overtime hour reduction, and Personal Days. Dr. Stegman made a motion to approve the EMoPP changes. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Brian Hendricks discussed approving the purchase of administrative staff vehicles for 2024 from Dan Brown, a 2024 Chevy Suburban and a 2024 Chevy Tahoe. The 2024 Chevy Suburban is \$58,120 and the 2024 Chevy Tahoe is \$51,672. Dr.

Stegman made a motion to approve the purchase of 2 staff vehicles, a 2024 Chevy Suburban and a 2024 Chevy Tahoe.



Director Hilmer yea.


Director Stegman yea.

Director Ryan yea.


There being no further business, Mr. Hilmer adjourned the meeting at 5:50 p.m.




