

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE MEHLVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF  
ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, ON THE  
17<sup>th</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2024

The Board of Directors of the Mehlville Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, met at the Mehlville Conference Room, 11020 Mueller Road, St. Louis County, Missouri, on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024.

Present at the meeting were:

Aaron Hilmer, Chariman and Director of the Board;

Bonnie C. Stegman, Treasurer and Director of the Board;

Edmond Ryan, Secretary and Director of the Board; and

Brian Hendricks, Fire Chief of the Mehlville Fire Protection District.

Mr. Hilmer called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and announced the Board to be in session for transaction of business.

Dr. Stegman made a motion to pay the bills of July 11 and 17, 2024. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was approved.

Mr. Ryan made a motion to approve the minutes of June 5 and 19, 2024. Dr. Stegman seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Financial Officer Brian Bond presented the June 2024 Treasurer's Report. The District received \$73k of tax revenue receipts. Cash equivalent resources totaled \$34.161M. The District received a net payment of \$773k related to the GEMT cost report. Capital expenditures included \$43k for architectural renovation fees and \$418k related to 50 new radios. Both the General Fund and the Pension Fund appear to be on course with the budget. Dr. Stegman made a motion to approve the June 2024 Treasurer's report. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Ty Cardona discussed negotiation items with the Board.

Chief Hendricks recommended to the Board the removal from probation for Fire Medic Anthony Risvold and Critical Care Registered Nurse Ryan Awaad. Dr. Stegman made a motion to approve the removal from probation. Mr. Ryan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Chief Hendricks discussed EMOPP changes.

Chief Hendricks discussed the apparatus replacement for a purchase of an ambulance in 2026.



Director Ryan yea.


There being no further business, Mr. Hilmer adjourned the meeting at 5:15 p.m.






